

#### GOSPEL REFLECTION Matthew 21:28-32

Jesus tells a parable to a group of religions leaders. He wants them to figure out which one of the sons did His Father's will. Was it the one who said yes but never showed up? Or was it the one who said no but later repented and carried our the Father's wishes. Sometime people can deceive us by smooth talk but God is never deceived. Like Jesus, our lives can be a "yes" to God the Father in word and deed.

Discussion Questions: Have you ever said "yes" to someone and then not done what you agreed to do? Did you ever say "no" to someone but then regretted it and changed your mind? Jesus is making it clear that sinners who repent are entering the kingdom before the priests and elders who did not repent and believe. What do you think of this?
