This Tuesday, Sept. 5th is the Feast Teresa of Calcutta. She was beatified only 6 years later, on Oct. 19, 2003. Mother Teresa often said that the poorest of the poor were those who had no one to care for them and no one who knew them. She often remarked with sadness and desolation of millions of souls in the developed world whose spiritual poverty and loneliness was such an immense cause of suffering. She was a fierce defender of the unborn saying: *"If you hear of some woman who does not want to keep her child and wants to have an abortion, try to persuade her to bring him to me. I will love that child, seeing in him the sign of God's love."* Mother Teresa once said, *"A sacrifice to be real must cost, must hurt, must empty ourselves. The fruit of silence is prayer, the fruit of prayer is faith, the fruit of faith is love, the fruit of love is service, the fruit of service is peace."* She also said, *"give yourself fully to God. He will use you to accomplish great things on the condition that you believe much more in His love than in your own weakness."* Here is the daily prayer of Mother Teresa: *Dear Jesus, help me spread Thy fragrance everywhere I go. Flood my soul with Thy Spirit and love. Penetrate and possess my whole being so utterly that all my life may be a radiance of Thine. Shine through me and be in me that every soul I come in contact with may feel Thy presence in my soul. Let them see no longer me but only Jesus. Stay with me then I shall begin to shine as you shine so to be a light to others. Amen.*

.ST. ANTHONY HALL DEMOLITION

As indicated earlier, the church hall which has been closed for close to a year by direction of the Diocese, is nearing demolition.

At the time of writing, the diocese is finalizing the steps in preparation for its demolition. Our target date is **September 18th 2017** and although we do not have a total figure of the cost, it will be in the neighbourhood of \$50,000 plus. Electrical, plumbing and other disconnections will be extra as will be engineers fees.

Although not at this time, it is planned to fill the open area with a much needed parking lot, albeit small.

We were blessed with a very successful fundraiser for the house, church and chapel roof shingling last fall and hopefully we will be as successful in raising the needed funds for the demolition.

While there is very little to salvage from the building there are a number of church pews that parishioners might be interested in purchasing. Available would be: 3 pews (7 ½ long); 2 pews (18 ½ long); 1 pews (13 ½ long); 1 pew (6 feet long) . These pews could be used as deacon benches to place in a hallway or in the basement. The purchaser would be responsible for pick-up and this would have to be done on one set day, as entrance into the hall is closed due to health regulations. This date will be decided upon depending on the number of sales. The cost for the pews as is: short pews: \$175 and long \$250. All monies collected for the sale will go towards the cost of the demolition.

I would ask that all parishioners prayerfully consider making a donation to cover the cost of the demolition. Please make your cheque payable to St. Anthony's parish, and write "**Demolition**" *on the outside of the envelope*. This is the only way an income tax receipt may be issued either for cheque or cash. Just be sure to include your name and address on the envelope.
