**GOSPEL REFLECTION****Mark 9:38-43, 45, 47-48**

Like Moses before Him, Jesus wants God's healing power to be shared by as many as possible. When a disciple complains about a man who is healing in Jesus' name but who is not one of their company, Jesus assures him, "Anyone who is not against us is with us." Doing good is not to be restricted to an exclusive few. Giving good example to the "little ones" or those of simple faith will be rewarded. Anyone who leads them astray deserves punishment. Since our hands, our feet, and our eyes can lead us into sin, we are to use them in ways that honor God's kingdom of love, justice, and peace. By doing so, we help to make God's reign visible in our midst.
