FROM OUR CATECHISM

How do Christians make Sunday "the Lord's day"?

A Catholic Christian attends Holy Mass on Sunday or on the vigil of Sunday. On that day he refrains from work that would prevent him from worshipping God or disturb the festive, joyful, restful, and restorative character of the day.

Since Sunday is an Easter celebration that occurs each week, Christians from the earliest times have gathered on that day to celebrate and thank their Redeemer and to reunite themselves with Him and with others who are redeemed. So it is a central duty of every conscientious Catholic Christian to "keep holy" Sunday and the other holy days of the Church. One is exempted from it **only** by urgent family duties and important responsibilities in society. **Because participation in the Sunday Eucharist is fundamental for a Christian life, the Church explicitly declares that it is a serious sin to stay away from Sunday Mass without a good reason.**
