**GOSPEL REFLECTION**

Matthew 18:15-20

One of the ways Christians show their love for one another is to offer guidance and correction. Jesus expects His disciples to be "watchers", as Ezekiel was. When a member of the community seriously sins against them, they are to speak about it to that person in private. If the sinner refuses to listen, two or three disciples are to offer correction. And if that fails, the entire community should call the sinner to repent.

*Discussion Questions: What is the connection between warning someone who is doing something wrong and loving them? Why is the first step "keep it between the two of you"? When someone corrects you, how does it feel? At first? Later? Do you listen? Do you change?*
