GOSPEL REFLECTION

Mark 7:31-37

What was promised in today's first reading we see fulfilled in the Gospel. A man who is deaf and suffers from a speech impediment is taken by his friends to see Jesus. Moved by the man's pitiful condition, Jesus takes him aside i and performs a healing ritual. He concludes by praying that the man's senses "Be opened!" And the man begins! immediately to hear and speak plainly. Despite Jesus' command to keep the miracle a secret, the crowd goes wild with excitement and spreads the news throughout the region. They praise Jesus because "He has done everything! well!" Jesus, however, does not want them to expect a Messiah who will bring them political power and economic riches. He was a Messiah who used God's power only to serve others and not to avoid suffering himself.

Discussion Questions: In what way is the man who is healed a sign of the Messiah's presence? What does the example of Jesus teach us about how we! are to respond to those who are physically challenged?

I wanted to take this opportunity to thank the parishioners of St. Anthony's, St. John's and Star of the Sea for your love, friendship and


