

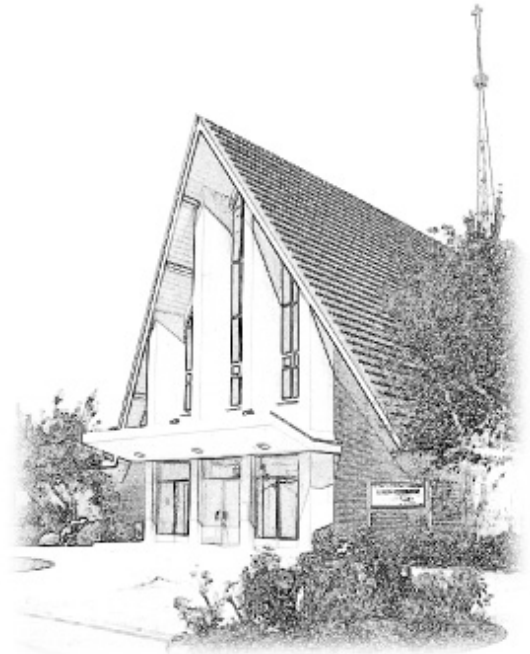

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul has designated November 17th, which Pope Francis declared World Day of the Poor, as a day in which we are encouraged to consider those less fortunate than ourselves and to give generously what we can. Canadians in need struggle to buy their children winter clothing and afford the increased cost of heating their homes. This is why even more people than usual turn to organizations like the Society of St. Vincent de Paul for help. The desire to provide for their family causes them to humble themselves and seek help. On November 17th you can place food donations, hygiene products or baby diapers in the food box in the narthex.
