

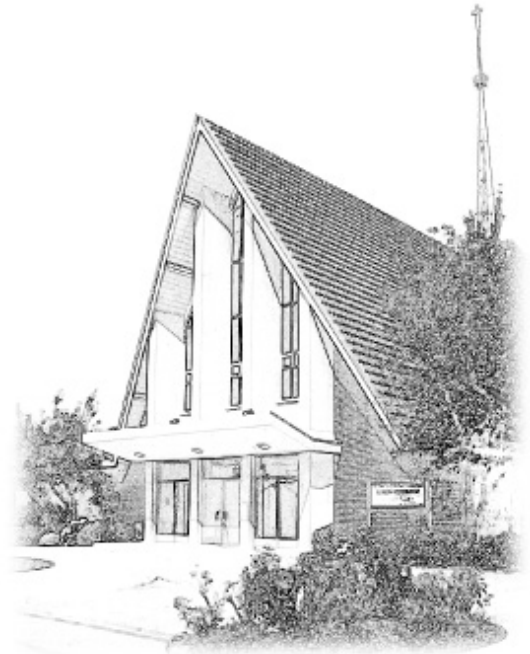

During the months of June, July, August and September, 44 visits were made to families in need. Food vouchers were given to these families. The cost of these vouchers was \$5,570. Twenty four families were provided with fresh fruit and vegetables from the Halton Fresh Food Box program. Back to school supplies were given to 45 children from 26 families.
