

### SERRA CLUB

The relic of St. Junipero Serra will be present for Masses for Serra Canada on Sunday, September 30. Pray with a Saint! St. Junipero Serra was a priest and Franciscan friar who left a comfortable life in Spain in 1749 at the age of 35 to sail to what is today Mexico and journey by foot, despite leg injury, through Mexico and into California. He established the first nine of 31 Spanish missions in California before his death in 1784. The first class relic is a piece of bone from one of St. Junipero's toes which was given to Serra International when his grave was last opened in 1947. Bishop Crosby referenced, "The relic of St. Junipero Serra, the Patron of Serra International is 'visiting' in Halton – an opportunity to pray ever more fervently for vocations and for our 21 seminarians who recently began another year of study!"

#### **DIOCESE** to move ahead with capital campaign

The Diocese of Hamilton has decided to move forward with a Parish-focused capital campaign after a recent study found support from 83 percent of the respondents. The planning study was conducted from May through June by the Steier Group, a campaign consulting firm, and included more than 900 clergy and lay participants. Under the proposed campaign plan. 75 percent of the funds raised would go to the Parishes for projects of their choosing, 15 percent to diocesan ministries and 10 percent to support Parishes in diocesan campaign need.
