

Dear Parishioners,

This past September we initiated all day adoration at St. Mary's Church. Every Friday from 9am-8pm the church is open and Jesus is placed on the altar. But if we work at this together, we will deepen our relationship with the one whom St. Augustine said, "our hearts are restless until they rest in [him]."




