





Deep Within *a woman’s perspective*

Do you remember the Mary Tyler Moore episode where she is sick with a bad cold, she sprains her ankle and her hair will not curl...all on the day she is to receive a special news award? She hobbles to the podium, leans into the microphone and says in a congested voice, “I usually look so much better.”

Obviously this has stuck with me for a couple of decades. I remember laughing so hard at that line. I

loved Mary Tyler Moore and I felt for her, when she looked and acted less than her usual perfect self.

I’ve been reminded of this lately, not because I come close to resembling the star of that great sit-com, but for the fact that I’ve been having some issues myself. I’ve wanted to explain on more than one occasion, ‘I usually feel so much better.’

Driving to work I contemplated the various issues with my health that are now plaguing me - all at once. I looked heavenward, asking, ‘What are you trying to tell me?’

In the first piece I ever wrote for the bulletin, I tackled the Gospel story of Peter’s mother-in-law. I took issue with the part where Jesus healed her and immediately she got up and began to serve everyone. While I was working on that piece, Fr. Dave gave me a book that delved deeper into the Gospel stories and, in reference to Peter’s mother-in-law, it explained that sickness, in Jesus’ time, had more to do with one’s spiritual health; also, sickness was a tremendous burden to the family – everyone had to pull their weight. Ten years after writing the piece, I am reminded of that explanation, and wondering why now is any different from then? Why wouldn’t our physical and our spiritual health be connected?

When the wordings in the Catholic liturgy changed (2011?), my sister Patti was unhappy with one prayer in particular: “Lord I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.”

“I don’t like it,” she said, “I want to keep saying, ‘and I shall be healed.’” But I thought, ‘ah-ha, that connection is still there – between physical health and spiritual health – it’s still there.’

It is, so it’s time to pray and to dig down deep.

*Deep within, I will plant my law, not on stone, but in your heart. Follow me, I will bring you back, you will be my own and I will be your God.*
