week. Why, you may ask? Well, we (priests) have finally moved into the rental house, and our offices are fully functioning and are now open. Yes, we are back. Thank you to everyone who helped us, especially my friend Roger and his son Jacob. With the help of Roger's small trailer, we were able to move all the furniture to the

house, and it only took 15 trips. The good Lord provided us with a week of record high temperatures, so the move allowed us with a good workout. There is still work to be done in emptying the rectory of all that still remains, but this will pass. We hope to have the rectory completely cleaned out and ready for demolition by the end of July. The Building Committee continues to work hard on preparing for the next stage of our Building Project.

Regarding our parish Masses, we have seen a steady increase in numbers. People are coming back to church, and it is beautiful to see. With the proper protocols in place, we are trying to keep people safe while providing an opportunity to worship God and receiving Holy Communion. For those unable to attend, we offer live stream of the rosary with priests Monday through Friday at 9pm. We will also make Sunday mass available online once again starting this weekend. You will find it on our website.

God willing I will be taking 7 days away from the parish at the beginning of August. Yes, I am going on my annual motorcycle trip with 3 other priests. Last year we went to Victoria, BC and back in 2 weeks. This year, because of travel restrictions, we will stay in Ontario (well and just beyond). We will be going to Edmonton through Timmins, and back through Espanola. I will try to connect with all of you along my trip, but more on that in the coming weeks.

## \*In the Parish \*

#### **Safety Measures for Returning to Church**:

As of Tuesday, June 16th, we have begun to offer public Masses once again in our churches. Given the number of restrictions still in place, Bishop Crosby has extended his dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass for those who may feel uncomfortable to attend at this point. Please make your own decision in this regard. Anyone who is feeling sick or who has travelled outside the country in the last 14 days is asked not to come to church. Our weekend Masses will be offered in Owen Sound, Meaford, Chatsworth, and Wiarton. After consulting with parishioners I have decided not to open Tobermory, Lions Head, and Sauble missions at this time. If you live in those regions and would like to attend Sunday Mass, please consider going to either Wiarton or Owen Sound for now.

We will be following the safety protocol while at church, as has been outlined in Bishop Crosby's letter to parishioners. Here are a few highlights in summary form:

 When you arrive at the church doors you will be greeted by one of our ushers who will open the door for you and invite you to sanitize your hands

- You'll be asked to sit in such a way as to respect the social distancing rule of 2 meters. Members of the same household do not have to follow that rule and can sit together.
- Wearing safety masks is encouraged, and we will have some available for those who need them.
- All printed materials will be removed from the pews: hymnals, Sunday missals, etc. Music will be provided by an instrumentalist and a cantor. Choirs are not permitted.
- 5. There will be no lectors or extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion during this time. The priest will be the only one in the sanctuary.
- When coming up for Holy Communion, social distancing of 2 meters will be observed. One side of the church will come up for Communion, in a single row, and then the other side.
- 7. Before reaching the priest the mask will be lowered, and Communion is to be offered without any exchange of words between the priest and the communicant.
- 8. Collection is to be placed in the baskets on the way out of church, and there should be no socializing with one another before or after Mass.
- Printed bulletins will not be available, instead parishioners will be able to view the bulletin on our website.
- 10. Confession will not be offered before or after Mass, but we continue to offer Confession by appointment in a drive-thru format.

I hope that all these steps undertaken by our churches will provide extra protection for our parishioners and their loved ones. Please follow these as best as you can. I hope to see you soon as we return to a somewhat normal church practice.

Interestingly, as we began to use these new means of communication, parishioners began to ask if we need the funds to build and improve the platforms we are using, and our regular donations began to pour back in." – Fr. Con O'Mahony

**St. John Brebeuf, Erin** - Fr. Don Sanvido conducted a survey to gauge how his community was doing during the crisis. A couple of the responses from his parishioners: "I had a long talk with my family. We had not attended Mass regularly prior to COVID, but we are now praying the rosary as a family and vow to never miss Mass again for any selfish reason." "The pandemic has taught us how to be a family again. We are praying together, eating meals together and playing together as a family. I pray the lessons we have learned during this crisis are not forgotten. My family has become stronger because of this."
