



The Month of Celebrations



The month of June is the month of Solemnities. Three out of the four Sundays in June are marked by special celebrations: Pentecost, Trinity Sunday, and Corpus Christi. I would like to take some time over the next few weeks to reflect on each of these.

Pentecost Sunday, which we celebrate this weekend, is a commemoration of that event in the history of the Church. The time when the Holy Spirit descended on the Blessed Mother Mary and the Apostles fifty days after the resurrection of Jesus. This event marks the birthday of the Church, because without the power and work of the Holy Spirit, the Apostles would not have been able to continue the ministry of Jesus through the Church. Jesus promised his Apostles that He will send the great gift of the Holy Spirit who will teach them all things and guide them in what to do.
