

From the Pastor's Desk:

Dear Parishioners,

This week brought with it some very sad news. On Tuesday an email came from the chancery office informing the whole diocese that Fr. Kuzma has requested a permanent leave of absence from priestly ministry and intends to leave the priesthood.

I am sure that many of you, like me, are shocked by this announcement. It is always sad when a priest who served so faithfully leaves the ministry.

At this point it sounds like the process of laicization (returning to the lay state) has only begun. Locally, our bishop has accepted Fr. Kuzma's request. Next, a letter will be sent to Rome requesting laicization, an act that only Rome can do. It may take a few months before Rome answers.

In the meantime, Fr. Kuzma will not be permitted to perform priestly ministry or even present himself as a priest.

This is sad news indeed. While we don't know what Fr. Kuzma is experiencing, we can help him with our prayers. Please pray for him and for all who are affected by this news.
