





Walk in Another's Shoes a woman's perspective There's been a lot of talk lately about illegal aliens and refugees. There's much animosity building, in many parts of the world including right here on our own continent. I think the majority of citizens in the U.S. and Canada seem to have forgotten their heritage. If our ancestors are not indigenous to this continent, then, did they not arrive here themselves, uninvited?

Sometimes, when I 'm running, or walking our country road, or driving in my car alone, I ponder what is and what might have been. I thank God every day for my home, my family...my freedom. But what if I had not been so privileged? A wife and mother living for years on end in a refugee camp? A child born to a family fleeing violence in Iraq, or Syria? Gang violence in Mexico forcing me to flee from all that is familiar, believing that slipping into an antagonistic country illegally is a better option?

I can't help but feel that if we all contemplated these scenarios, we might treat others more kindly. I don't know why I've been given this life when hundreds of thousands suffer on a daily basis, but nothing gives me the right to feel superior; to laud it over any other human being.

I can't begin to offer solutions to this ongoing dilemma, but I believe prayer is a powerful tool. If we pray that world leaders can come together to work out solutions; if we pray that nations, that allow these atrocities to happen, are made accountable...perhaps those countries being overrun with more immigrants than they can handle will get a respite. If these issues cannot be resolved soon, and people continue to come, can't we accept those fleeing to our shores with kindness and respect? Our own heritage should make us stop and think - didn't many of our ancestors suffer in a similar manner? And what if a member of your family was trying to escape violence and being denied an opportunity for a better life?

Who are our neighbours? Technology, which brings global news to us in an instant, has actually brought us in line with Jesus' teaching - everyone is our neighbour. Let us try to be more tolerant. Let us open our hearts with compassion, and our arms with love. Let us pray.

A Seminarian's Thoughts:

So how can a young teenage boy (I was thirteen at the time) be so convinced of his vocation to serve God in the priesthood? The answer? He can't! No one can be sure at that age. But one can be generous with God and offer oneself wholeheartedly to follow whatever his holy will may be. And if we do that much, Almighty God will take care of the rest. And so, throughout that year of 2000-01, the Legionary brothers would visit our home, answer my parents' objections, and reassure us all that this was God's calling (for now) to my young self. The Lord would not lead me down the wrong path.

The summer of 2001 couldn't arrive soon enough. We new recruits were due to arrive at Immaculate Conception Apostolic School in Center Harbor, New Hampshire on 25 July. The day before, my dad drove me to another fellow's place in Toronto, and from there we began the 14-hour drive east. We arrived late, after dark, and a Legionary brother greeted us and led us with whispers and a flashlight to the huge open dormitory and our beds. It had been a long day, but it still took me quite a while to fall asleep. I was excited and nervous but ready to begin. At 6:30am the blinding fluorescent lights beamed on, full-blast, and our superiors patrolling the halls yelled out, "Christ our King!" I sat up groggily, in a daze—what had I got myself into?

Diocese to Move Ahead with Capital Campaign - The Diocese of Hamilton has decided to move forward with a Parish-focused capital campaign after a recent study found support from 83 percent of the respondents. The planning study was conducted from May through June by the Steier Group, a campaign consulting firm, and included more than 900 clergy and lay participants. Under the proposed campaign plan, 75 percent of the funds raised would go to the Parishes for projects of their choosing, 15 percent to diocesan ministries and 10 percent to support Parishes in need.
