

# From the Pastor's Desk:

Are you saved? I was walking home one day and came upon 2 young men dressed in suits and carrying a Bible. They stopped me and asked politely: "Are you saved?" I'm sure many of us have had that experience, as many of our separated brothers and sisters like to use this as an opening line in speaking about the Christian faith. How should we respond to this

question? The answer is given to us by St. Paul who encourages us "to work out our salvation every day with fear and trembling".

As followers of Jesus we have to make one thing very clear, faith alone is not sufficient for salvation. Don't get me wrong, faith is necessary for salvation, but never faith alone, by itself. Faith must be accompanied by good works. Jesus reminds us of this when He says: "Not everyone that says to me Lord, Lord, will enter the Kingdom of God; but he who does the will of my Father in Heaven" (Mt 7:21). Faith, therefore, must be accompanied by obedience to the will of God. In the Old Testament we read the words of Yahweh to Moses: "If you love me, you will keep my commandments". Faith has to be tested and tried by our faithfulness to God's commandments. The commandment of God are His gift to us; they tell us what God's will for us is and allows us to express our faith in action. Only in this way can we be saved.

When asked which commandment is the greatest, Jesus speaks of the commandment of Love: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, mind, soul and strength. This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is Love your neighbor as yourself". Jesus unites the two commandments forever, which means that we can never pick one and ignore the other.


