WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a Minor Basilica by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's Coat of Arms presents a shield sheltered by the ombrellino, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - every eye shall see him.

MASS INTENTIONS

We offer Masses for specific intentions on weekdays and Saturday 5:00 p.m. You may request a Mass Intention for a minimum offering of \$10. The intention of our Sunday morning Mass is *Missa pro populo* – Mass for the People which the Rector is required by Church law to offer each week. To arrange for a Mass Intention contact our Parish Office. Our weekly Wednesday (12 Noon) and Saturday (5 p.m.) Masses are *multi-intentional* meaning that several intentions can be remembered at these liturgies.

RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

Three important elements help us prepare to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion at Mass:

FAST – we are encouraged to fast from food and drink (except water) for one hour before receiving Holy Communion.

DISPOSITION – we should recognize the immense gift given to us in the Eucharist and the privilege we have of sharing in it.

CONFESSION – if we are aware of serious, or even mortal sins, we should celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

HOW TO RECEIVE?

The reception of Holy Communion is governed by particular law established by the Canadian Conference of Bishops and by the local Bishop. In his Pastoral Letter on the celebration of the liturgy in the Diocese of Hamilton, Bishop Crosby reminds us of how we are expected to receive Holy Communion at Mass. Namely, as we approach the minister distributing Holy Communion - usually as the person in front of us is in the act of receiving Holy Communion we make a simple bow of the head in reverence for the gift we are about to receive. There is no need to genuflect, or make a profound bow. Then, standing before the minister, there are ancient ways for receiving Holy Communion - in the hand or on the tongue. The minister, holding up the Sacred Host says, The Body of Christ, and we say - audibly -"Amen." Then we either open our hands or our mouth to receive. If we receive in the hand, we immediately take the Sacred Host and place it in our mouth. We do not take the Sacred Host with us to our pew.

COMMUNION TO THE SICK

If you wish to take Holy Communion to a relative who is sick at home please speak with Father Wynen prior to Mass – there is a special container and prayers for Communion to the Sick.

REVERENCE OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

When we pass in front of the Tabernacle, or go into our pew, it is customary to *genuflect* or bow in reverence. At the Cathedral Parish we have the custom of the whole assembly standing as the Blessed Sacrament is reposed in the Tabernacle after the distribution of Holy Communion. All are seated when the Tabernacle doors close.

WHO CAN RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION?

Catholics who have already received their first Holy Communion, and who have the proper disposition, may receive Holy Communion at Mass. The reception of Holy Communion is a sign that the one receiving is in communion with all that the Catholic Church believes, professes, and proclaims to be revealed by God. Christians of other denominations are welcome to attend the celebration of the Eucharist, but may not receive Holy Communion because their denomination is not in communion with the Catholic Church. Nonbaptized individuals may not receive Holy Communion. Adults who wish to become Catholic may inquire about the RCIA process which prepares adults for the celebration of Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist.

CONGRATULATIONS

Congratulations to the parents of several children who will be Baptized in our Parish in the next few weeks. Congratulations also to Grade 2 children who will receive their First Holy Communion in our Parish. We also congratulate young people who will be Confirmed by Bishop Crosby on Saturday, May 6 at 5 p.m. Mass. The celebration of these Sacraments are a wonderful opportunity for our Parish to celebrate the faith in the lives of these families, children and young people. May the Lord Jesus, who desires to be close to us all, lead these children and young people and keep them close to His Sacred Heart. May Mary, our Mother, spread her mantle of love over them to protect them.
