

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him.*

INSTALLATION OF ORGAN CONSOLE

The installation of our new organ console will begin on Tuesday and should be concluded by the end of April. The work entails removing the current console and related equipment and the installation of the new by Casavant Freres of Quebec. During the installation process the choir gallery will be closed. Our choir will move down to the side aisle on the East side of the Cathedral. A piano will be placed there and Rob will play and conduct the choirs in that location. The installation of the new console is part of the ongoing restoration of our 83 year old organ. Thanks to Bishop Crosby for his support of this important work.

CONSTRUCTION ZONE ...

The work continues on the exterior of our buildings. The front of the Rectory has been completed – except for some minor touch ups at ground level – and work begins on the Cathedral and Bishop's Residence. In addition to repointing the stone and replacing the roof, we intend to clean the stone. Over the course of this year you will notice the scaffolding will move from section to section of the building as the work progress.

The ongoing construction work means a few adjustments in our schedules at the Cathedral. We will try our best to not inconvenience our parishioners or visitors ... however, it seems best that our Funeral Celebrations should take place in neighbouring Parishes. Father Dave will preside at these celebrations. Thanks to our neighbours for their hospitality. Most funerals will take place at St. Thomas in Waterdown – a large church with parking! Weddings – most of which take place on Saturdays – will likely not be impacted by construction.


