

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him.*

#### **CARILLON RENOVATION**

The repair and renovation of the Cathedral Basilica's Carillon has been completed. Our 23 bell Carillon is one of only 11 Carillon instruments in Canada. The repair and renovation work was carried out by the Verdin Company and included the installation of strike clappers (rather than the bells swinging) and an automated electric strike on 5 bells. This gives us the ability to have a three or five bell peal for festive occasions. A new clavier (Carillon keyboard) was installed along with a shelter to protect the keyboard and the player from the elements. Thanks to the Diocese for their support.
