

The Most Reverend D. DOUGLAS CROSBY, OMI, DD *Bishop of Hamilton*

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

The annual ShareLent Collection in support of the good work of the *Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace* will be taken up today. Thank you for your support.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

During these weeks of Lent they are called to prepare themselves with more intensive prayer and action for the reception of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist.

Today, we will celebrate the *Rite of Scrutiny* for the Elect. These Rites are based on the Gospel passages for these Sundays – the man born blind, and the raising of Lazarus – all found in the Gospel of John. Having heard the passage proclaimed at Mass our community prays that the Holy Spirit will deepen the conversion experience of the Elect so that they will come to know Jesus Christ as our Saviour. The Elect then leave the Assembly to continue their reflection on the Gospel while the community continues its celebration of the Eucharist.

Our Elect are also joined by two baptized Christians who are seeking full communion with the Catholic Church through the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist.

Please pray for the Elect and our Candidates for full communion as they prepare to become members of the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil next Saturday.

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

Our Parish will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation for Grade 7 students enrolled at Canadian Martyrs School and for any other Grade 7 (or 8) students who are parishioners here. The Confirmation celebration will take place on <u>Sunday</u>, <u>November 23rd, 2014</u> at the <u>4:00 p.m.</u> Mass. Bishop Crosby will confer the Sacrament. Registration forms and further information will be available in September.

RECEPTION OF FIRST COMMUNION

Our Parish's 1st Communion Mass will be celebrated on <u>Sunday</u>, <u>June 22nd</u> at the <u>11:00 a.m.</u> Mass. On that day the Church celebrates the *Feast of Corpus Christi* – the Body and Blood of the Lord. This is for children in Grade 2 (or older) who have not yet made their 1st Holy Communion. Registration forms are available on our Parish's website. A series of parent/child meetings will begin in May.

GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION

On Good Friday a special collection will be taken up for the work of the Catholic Church in the Holy Land. This annual worldwide collection assists the Christian community in providing churches, schools and opportunities to live and worship in the place where Jesus lived.


