### **WELCOME!**

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

# Exterior Lighting of the Cathedral

In the coming weeks the exterior lights which shine on the Cathedral during the evening hours will be switched to LED bulbs. We anticipate this move will offer considerable savings in energy and costs in the long run. Additionally, the exterior lights shining on the Rosary windows (Sanctuary) will be converted to LED and will be timed to come on in the evening.

### **Mass Intentions**

A fine Catholic tradition is to remember those who have gone before us through the celebration of the Eucharist. We accept intentions for our Daily Masses (8:00 a.m. Tuesday through Friday) and our Saturday 5:00 p.m. Mass. The Saturday 5:00 p.m. Mass is a "multi-intentional Mass" meaning that there are up to five intentions accepted for that Mass. The usual offering for Masses in the Diocese of Hamilton is \$10. Our Sunday Masses do not have a specific intention as they are celebrated "for the people" (missa pro populo). Intentions can be arranged by contacting our Parish Office. Any intentions which cannot be satisfied in the Parish within one year are shared with the Missions.

New Catholics from across our Diocese will join His Excellency, Bishop Douglas Crosby for Mass on Saturday, April 21 at 5:00 p.m. in the Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King. All are welcome to participate in this Mass. Reception to follow. # Monsignor Edward House

This past week - in the Easter Octave - we mourned the death of our beloved Monsignor Edward House (Rector 2001 - 2013). He died on his 71st birthday - March 29th - Holy Thursday. Monsignor served as a Priest of the Diocese of Hamilton since his ordination in 1975. Having served as an Associate Pastor in several Parishes, he was also the Diocesan Spiritual Advisor to the CWL and had a tour of duty as a Chaplain with the Canadian Armed Forces. Returning to the Diocese he served as Pastor of Immaculate Heart of Mary, Chepstow; Holy Cross Parish, Georgetown; Saint Anthony Daniel Parish, Kitchener; Rector of the Cathedral Basilica; and Pastor at Holy Rosary Parish, Burlington until his retirement from active ministry in 2016. Monsignor was the youngest child of a large and active family. He took great delight in offering warm hospitality and - with the help of his sisters (who are great cooks) hosted many dinners for Priests. In the Parish, Monsignor's warmth and charity are well remembered. We thank God for this good Priest and pray that as he closed his eyes on this world, they opened to the dawning of the eternal light. Let us pray that he heard the words of his Master - well done, good and faithful servant, enter the joy of your Lord!

# Mary, Mother of the Church

Pope Francis recently established a new feast in the liturgical calendar of the Universal Church -Feast of Mary, Mother of the Church - this title of Our Lady emanated from the Second Vatican Council (1962 - 1965). The feast is to be celebrated each year on the Monday after Pentecost. This year it is an obligatory memorial which means that Priests who celebrate Mass that day must celebrate the feast. (It is not a holy day of obligation for the faithful.) At the Cathedral Basilica, His Excellency Bishop Crosby will celebrate the feast day with Mass at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, May 21st, 2018 - it happens to be Victoria Day, so if you are free please join us for Mass as we honour Our Lady under this important title.
