The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

## PASCHAL FAST

Good Friday and Holy Saturday are days of the *Paschal Fast* to honour the suffering and death of the Lord and to help us prepare to share more deeply in the joy of the resurrection. Catholics are to abstain from meat and those between the ages of 14 – 59 are encouraged to fast between meals. We might also consider eating more moderately during this time.

## SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

Our Parish will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation for Grade 7 students enrolled at Canadian Martyrs School and for any other Grade 7 (or 8) students who are parishioners here. The Confirmation celebration will take place on **Sunday, November 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2014** at the **4:00 p.m.** Mass. Bishop Crosby will confer the Sacrament. Registration forms and further information will be available in September.

## RECEPTION OF FIRST COMMUNION

Our Parish's 1<sup>st</sup> Communion Mass will be celebrated on **Sunday, June 22<sup>nd</sup>** at the **11:00 a.m.** Mass. On that day the Church celebrates the *Feast of Corpus Christi* – the Body and Blood of the Lord. This is for children in Grade 2 (or older) who have not yet made their 1<sup>st</sup> Holy Communion.
