

The Most Reverend D. DOUGLAS CROSBY, OMI, DD *Bishop of Hamilton*

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

The Sacrament Holy Orders

The Sacrament of Holy Orders carries on the mission of Christ to bring his Presence to the world through Word and Sacrament. There are three "orders" – Deacon, Priest and Bishop – which comprise this Sacrament. The *diaconate* is either **transitional** or **permanent**. A transitional deacon is one who is ordained to this Order before being ordained a Priest. At the time of the diaconate this candidate will pledge himself to life-long celibacy for the sake of the Kingdom of God and service to the Church. A permanent deacon is one who will not proceed to ordination as a Priest. Often the permanent deacon is already married. He, and his wife, with the assistance of the Church have discerned a call to be of service to the Church through the proclamation of the Word and works of charity in the name of the Bishop. To be ordained Priest a celibate deacon makes a further promise of obedience to the Bishop who shares with the candidate the gift of ordination through the laying on of hands. The Priest presides at the celebration of the Eucharist, and the other Sacraments, in the person of Christ for the good the Church and of the whole world. A Bishop is chosen by the Pope after consultation with local Catholic priests, bishops and lay faithful. Bishops are priests who are at least 35 years of age and have been ordained priests for a minimum of 10 years. They are to be men of good reputation and sound moral character. They are entrusted with a portion of God's people in a Diocese ... or to assist the Diocesan Bishop as an Auxiliary. Bishops are called to be Shepherds of God's people after the heart of the Good Shepherd. The Diocesan Bishop is the chief teacher, priest and leader of the local Church in union with the Bishop of Rome.

Priests can be ordained for the service of a local diocese ... they are known as "Diocesan Priests" and will spend their life serving a particular diocese. Diocesan priests take make a vow of celibacy and a promise of obedience to the Bishop. They are called to live simple lives in imitation of the Lord. Others who become members of a Religious Order are known as "Religious Priests" they spend their lives in community serving the particular mission of their Religious congregation. For example, Oblates of Mary Immaculate, (OMI) are a religious community of Priests and Brothers who follow the missionary charism of their founder – Saint Eugene de Mazenod. In Canada, they have traditionally served in the Northern territories among the Aboriginal and First Nations peoples. Religious take additional vows of poverty, chastity and obedience.
