

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him.*

2. MONSIGNOR IS ON THE ROAD AGAIN ...

Bishop Crosby has appointed Monsignor Sheridan the Administrator of Saint Mary Parish in Hamilton (our first Cathedral) until a new Pastor can be named. The appointment was effective August 12th. Monsignor will continue to live in the Cathedral Rectory and he maintains his responsibilities as Director of Diocesan Charities.

CATHEDRAL IS OPEN

During the months of July and August the Cathedral Basilica will be open to receive visitors who wish to view it or who wish to take time to pray. We will open from 10:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. Greeters will be available in the Cathedral to assist those who are visiting and to answer questions about the Cathedral Basilica.

RCIA

The *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults* will begin its Fall catechetical sessions on Wednesday, September 16th. Non-baptized adults, or baptized Christians, who wish to become members of the Catholic Church are

invited to speak with Father Dave in the coming weeks. Please contact the Parish Office for an appointment. Weekly sessions will be hosted by our Parish team. Rites are celebrated at important moments along the way to the celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation. SYMBOLON

We will be offering the SYMBOLON program in the Parish this Fall. It will form the catechetical component of the RCIA process. These sessions are open to all Parishioners who want to grow in their understanding of the Catholic faith. Further details will follow in the coming weeks.

The Concluding Rite

The Concluding Rites of the celebration of Mass are very simple. There may be some announcements for the interest of the Parish, and then the Presiding Priest offers a blessing – sometimes a Solemn

Blessing - and then he dismisses the Assembly. The dismissal is really an invitation to go and to live the mysteries celebrated until we gather again. procession out of the sanctuary may be accompanied by congregational singing or instrumental music. There is a temptation to leave the celebration before these Concluding Rites – sometimes people want to be the first out of the parking lot. Shouldn't we who have been fed with the presence of the Lord linger for a while? Leaving early (after the reception of Holy Communion) is a poor habit that needs to be broken. Leaving the celebration before the Concluding Rites is also disrespectful to the gathered Assembly. should make an effort to stay and pray. The celebration of the Sunday Eucharist is the source and summit of our Christian lives. It is a privilege for us to gather freely for the Mass - to hear the truth of God's holy word and to be nourished at the Saviour's Table!

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

We will be offering an opportunity for young children to participate in the Liturgy of the Word at the 9:00 a.m. Mass on the 3rd Sunday of each month beginning in September. The children will be invited forward at the beginning of Mass and then follow their leaders to the Marian Chapel. They will return to the Assembly (and their parents) at the time of the Presentation of the Gifts. In the coming weeks "sign up forms" will be available for parents who wish their children to participate – pre-school age to Grade 2. All volunteers participate in the Diocesan volunteer screening process which includes criminal background checks.

RED MASS

The Annual Red Mass will be celebrated at the Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King in Hamilton on Wednesday, September 9 at 9:30 a.m. The St. Thomas More Lawyers' Guild sponsors this annual Mass that originated in the 13th century.
