

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him.*

CONSULTATION ON REFUGEE SPONSORSHIP

Recently a letter was mailed to the homes of all envelope users and those who support the Parish with pre-authorized debits concerning whether our Parish will work to sponsor a refugee or refugee family. If you have not yet responded to the survey please do so. Based on your response and the level of interest among parishioners a determination will be made whether we can take on this project. A volunteer committee will need to be established to carry on the work of settling a refugee. We are looking for people who can commit a couple of hours per week for the next year to this work.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

The work of restoration of the Cathedral Basilica continues. Workers have removed the scaffold from the upper west side of the Cathedral – the work there is completed and the upper roof on that side is being installed. Scaffold has been completed on the upper east side. Cleaning of stone and repointing has begun. The tower is fully covered with scaffold. Cleaning of the tower and repointing of stone will begin soon. Most of the decorative pinnacles on the tower have to be replaced due to damage over the years. During this process the bells of the carillon will be protected and will ring on weekends only.
