WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a Minor Basilica by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's Coat of Arms presents a shield sheltered by the ombrellino, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - every eye shall see him.

2022 is going incredibly fast! Here we are in August ... what happened to June! This month I will be away from the Parish for some holiday and then at the end of the month, I will travel to Rome for a week. Summer in the Parish is relatively quiet - most of our weddings are in September and October. In July we welcomed several children into the life the Church through the waters of Baptism thanks to their parents for bringing them to the Church for this Sacrament. We bid farewell to Romano Piccini - a long-time Parishioner, our prayerful sympathies to his family. Seminarian - Deacon Jonathan Reitzel concluded his assignment here on July 31. After some holiday with his family, he returns to the Seminary in Wisconsin on August 19 for his final year of preparation for Ordination to the Priesthood. Congratulations to the couples who celebrated Holy Matrimony in July, pray those engaged couples who continue to prepare for their marriage.

Our Parish participated in a study conducted by the Diocesan Business Office of 20 parishes comparing their income from January – June 2019 to January – June 2022. Good news for us. The Cathedral Parish ranked #1 being down only 9% compared with 2019. Thanks to our Parishioners for their ongoing support. Other Parishes ... some much larger in population than ours ... are still down 30 and 40% over 2019.

As we continue to return to "normal" we must still be cautious. COVID infections are still a reality in our community. It pays to be careful in our contacts and interactions. Vaccines continue to be a valuable tool in lessening the effects of the infection.

Enjoy the rest of summer. Remember the 3 "d's" – *defer, delegate & delay* – not always in that order and sometimes all at once!!


