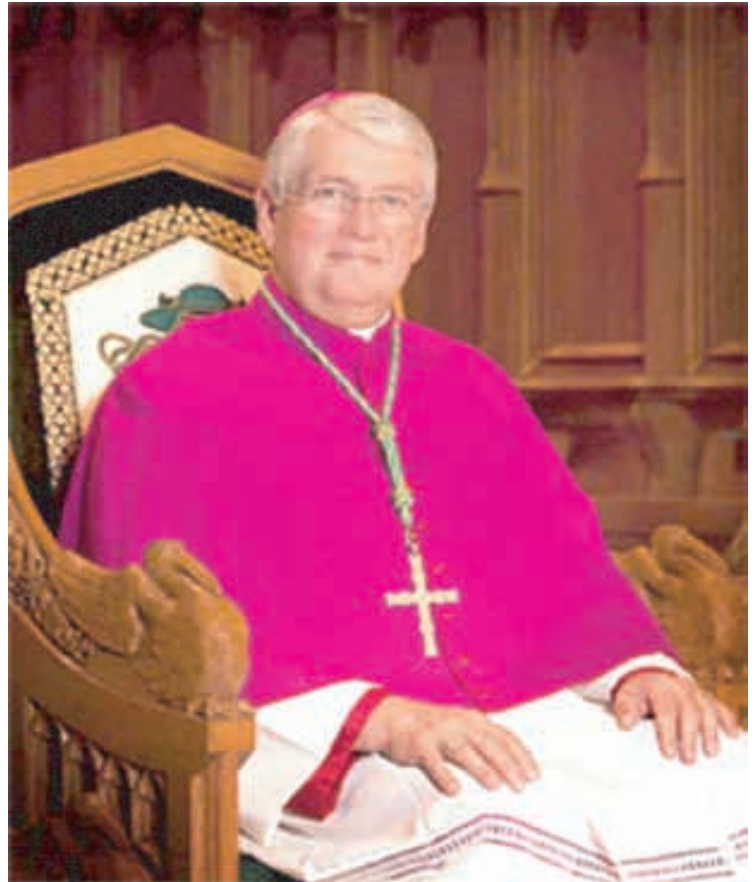

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

Summer series ...

The Sacrament of Marriage

Marriage is a *covenant* between a man and a woman through which they “establish between themselves a partnership of the whole of life, is by its nature ordered toward the good of the spouses and the procreation and education of children; this covenant between baptized persons has been raised by Christ the Lord to the dignity of a sacrament” (*Code of Canon Law*, 1055). It might seem strange to begin a brief reflection on marriage with a quote from Canon Law, but it is a good definition of what the Catholic Church believes marriage to be. The married state existed long before Christ walked the face of the earth. From the beginning men and women have entered into the married state out of love for each other and with the desire that their love would be fruitful. God’s blessing on marriage is seen again and again in the Old Testament. Often marriage was held up by the prophets of old in speaking of God’s love for his chosen people. Christ, our Saviour, raises this fundamental human institution to the dignity of a Sacrament – giving grace to the spouses to live their married life in harmony and fidelity to one another until death. We see that the love of husband and wife is a reflection of the love between Christ and His Bride, the Church. As Christ gave himself fully for the life of the Church – so spouses are called to imitate his self-sacrificing love in their marriage. In building “themselves a partnership of the whole of life” married couples are called to grow in trust of one another and of God. To see in the joys and struggles of married life the loving plan of God for them and their family. The Church also recognizes that some marriages do last until death. As a Christian community we offer our prayerful support and welcome to those who experience the difficulty of separation and divorce. In some situations a couple enters into a union that appears to be a valid marriage, but upon investigation is shown to be lacking in the essential qualities of a valid marriage. In these cases a *declaration of nullity* may be requested from the Church so that one or both of the parties can work to establish a true marriage with another partner. In the marriage covenant our human love mixes with Divine love in a wonderful way which brings life to the couple and new life to our world. Let us pray for all married couples, those engaged to be married, couples who struggle in difficult marriages, and those who experience the sadness of separation and divorce.


