WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin *every eye shall see him*.

SEASON OF ADVENT

Today is Gaudate Sunday - typically the midway-point of Lent. Historically, at a time when Advent was seen as a mini-Lent, with an emphasis on fasting and penance, the vestments for this Sunday would be *rose*. Liturgical rose is not pink – it is combination of purple and white - a sign that the austerities of penance would soon be replaced with the joy of Christmas. Today, the Season of Advent is a time of joyful preparation with a greater emphasis on hearing the words of the Baptist, "prepare the way of the Lord!" We prepare the way by growing in our loving service of others, deepening our life of prayer, and turning to the Lord in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. May these final days of Advent find us watchful and ready to welcome the Lord when he comes.

CAN WE JUST GO TO ONE MASS NEXT WEEK? This year, with Christmas on a Monday, we have lots of opportunities to celebrate our faith. Our Masses for the Fourth Sunday of Advent (December 24) are at the same times as our usual schedule. Sunday is the Lord's Day and it is our privilege to gather for the Eucharist. The first Mass of Christmas Eve is celebrated at 5:00 p.m. on December 24 (it doesn't count for the 4th Sunday of Advent). Christmas Day Masses are celebrated at Midnight and at 11:00 a.m. - Christmas is a holy day of obligation for Catholics. We celebrate the Messiah's birth with joy. The really good news is that we get to do it all again the following week. Sunday, December 31 is the Feast of the Holy Family with our regular Mass Schedule. January 1 is the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. Mass will be celebrated on New Year's Eve at 5:00 p.m. (it doesn't fulfill the Sunday obligation). At 11 a.m. we celebrate Mass for the feast on New Year's morning. The Eucharist is the source and summit of our Christian life. It is a privilege to gather for Mass in peace and in the joy of the Season. Let us also be mindful of the visitors who will join us our Christmas Masses - let us make them welcome among us at the Table of the Lord!
