The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

#### Christmas 2016

Dear brothers and sisters in the Lord,

Today, with the whole Church, we celebrate the joy of Jesus' birth more than 2,000 years ago in Bethlehem. For us this is more than an historical memorial. The birth of this infant changed our world and continues to change our lives. In the non-descript feed trough in an insignificant town the light of the world has dawned.

He is King of kings, Wonder-counsellor, and Mighty God! His is a singular birth that changes everything. In Jesus' birth, God has become one with us in our humanity and yet he remains fully God. The mystery of the incarnation invites us share in his divinity as he shares in our humanity. Each day we are called to conform our lives to Christ as we seek to follow him.
