

The Most Reverend D. DOUGLAS CROSBY, OMI, DD *Bishop of Hamilton*

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

IMMACULATE CONCEPTION

This year the Feast of the Immaculate Conception is observed on Monday, December 9th (rather than December 8th which is a Sunday). The Church defined its understanding of this mystery in 1854. Simply put, Mary was conceived in the womb of her mother – St. Ann – in the normal manner, but she was spared of the stain of original sin because of her future role as the mother of the Redeemer. We believe that baptism washes away original sin, so Mary shared in the grace of baptism before the Giver of baptism was born. God had chosen Mary from the world's foundation to be the "ark" through which the salvation of the world would be born. Let us rejoice in her feast.

There are two ways that you may submit your responses: Fill in the questionnaire which can be found at www.hamiltondiocese.com. The questionnaire seeks information on the faithful's understanding of various Church teachings on marriage and family. It can be completed on line, or printed and faxed or mailed to the Family Ministry Office. Deadline for submission is December 16. 2013. Attend a focus group gathering where the guestionnaire will be discussed and responses collected to include in the final report to be submitted by the end of December. This gathering will occur at St. Anthony Daniel Parish (Kitchener) on Saturday, December 14 from 10:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. and you are asked to RRSP by phone (905-528-7988 ext. 2249) or e-mail familyministry@hamiltondiocese.com. The preparatory information being gathered will provide essential input to the Bishops as they prepare for this Extraordinary Synod.
