The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a Minor Basilica by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's Coat of Arms presents a shield sheltered by the ombrellino, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - every eye shall see him.

SEASON OF LENT 2018

ASH WEDNESDAY Wednesday, February 14th, 2018

Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstaining from meat for Catholics – a day of penance – as we begin the Season of Lent. Join us for the celebration of Mass at which the mark of ashes will be imposed upon us. The ashes come from last year's palm branches used on Passion Sunday. Masses will be celebrated in the Cathedral Basilica:

Catholics who are older than 14 years should abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and those between the ages of 18 to 59 (in good health) are bound to These are privileged forms of fast. penance which are meant to open our hearts and minds to the presence of the Lord. These penances also unite us with the suffering of so many brothers and sisters around the world. The discipline of fasting can be continued throughout Lent as we may "give up" some treat for the 40 days until Easter. It's also a good practice to "take on" something good for Lent – acts of random kindness.

In addition to our regularly schedule 8:00 a.m. daily Mass (Tuesday through Friday) in the Marian Chapel, we will also offer Holy Mass at **12:00 Noon on Wednesdays** in Lent in the Cathedral Basilica. All are welcome!

Call for Conscience
