WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin *every eye shall see him.*

RCIA

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults continues its journey toward the Easter Sacraments. Please pray for our two candidates – one to be baptized and the other to be received into the full communion of the Catholic church. The weekly sessions will move to Canadian Martyrs Parish for the Season of Lent as the group will reflect on the spiritual life.

RITE OF ELECTION

Non-baptized adults and young people from across the Diocese of Hamilton will celebrate the Rite of Election with our Bishops on the First Sunday of Lent. This important Rite enrolls candidates as members of the "Elect" in preparation for full initiation - Baptism, Confirmation and first reception of Holy Communion - at the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday. Please pray the Elect. The books they sign at the Rite of Election will be located near our baptismal font through the Season of Lent. The Rites of Scrutiny take place on the 3rd, 4th, and 5th Sundays of Lent as we pray the Holy Spirit continue to strengthen the Elect on their Lenten journey to the joy of the Easter Sacraments.

RELIGIOUS INSTRUCTION FOR CHILDREN

Parents of children enrolled in Public or Private School and wish to offer Catholic religious instruction to the children should contact our Parish Office. The Diocese of Hamilton offers an excellent course of religious instruction at the appropriate grade level of the child. The program is by correspondence and helps children and parents complete the catechesis needed for the Sacraments and for an understanding of the Catholic faith.

WHAT TO "GIVE UP" FOR LENT?

While it is good to "give up" sweets and junk food for Lent, it is also a good idea to consider "taking on" some good habit. Perhaps during Lent, we might intentionally look for opportunities for charity in our talk and thoughts. We might look for opportunities to be of service to others. Bad habits are easy to get into, good habits take work!

How to Fast

Fasting can take different forms. People who are in good health may consider cutting back on the amount of food they consume at their meals on a fasting day, or two small meals may be taken and one full meal for a fasting day. Others may be able to fast completely, or have only bread and water. Which ever manner of fasting works for you, it is important to fast in the context of prayer. Also, it is important to fast with an intention in mind - perhaps for the millions of people in our world who go without food due to poverty and lack of food. The penance of fasting is not just about deprivation, but more importantly, to fast with intention. Then we can recognize our spiritual hunger for God who calls us to deeper conversion of heart during Lent.

SEASON OF LENT

The Season of Lent - 40 days of *prayer*, *fasting*, and *almsgiving* - begins on Ash Wednesday. Please join us for our Lenten observances.

Ash Wednesday - February 14, 2024

Ashes (from last year's palm branches) will be imposed during the celebration of Mass in the Cathedral Basilica:

8:00 a.m. 12:00 Noon 7:00 p.m.

Ash Wednesday is a penitential day for Catholics. This means that all Catholics are bound to abstain from eating meat. Further, Catholics between the ages of 14 to 59, who are in good health, are bound by the law of fasting. This means that we might have one large meal instead of three on this day. It may also take the form of three, significantly smaller meals. Some go as far as not eating on Ash Wednesday. Fridays of Lent are days of fast and abstinence from meat for Catholics in Canada.

Stations of the Cross

A traditional devotion praying at the 14 steps of Jesus' journey to the Cross with a different meditation each week. The Stations will be preceded by a reflection on the Sacrament of Reconciliation:

Stations at **7:00 p.m. each Friday of Lent**. A brief talk will precede the Stations:

February 16th Reality of Sin February 23rd Signs of Slippage

March 1st Examination of Conscience
March 8th Celebrating Reconciliation
March 15th The Father of Mercies
March 22nd Go, your sins are forgiven
