

## WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a Minor Basilica by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's Coat of Arms presents a shield sheltered by the ombrellino, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - every eye shall see him.

## COUNTDOWN TO LENT

The Season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 26. Ashes (from last year's palm branches) will be blessed and imposed during Mass in the Cathedral Basilica at **8:00 a.m.; 12:00 Noon** and **7:00 p.m.** All are welcome. Plan to join us for the *Lenten Retreat* a series of weekly reflections on Tuesdays with guest speakers. Our first session will be on Tuesday, March 3<sup>rd</sup> with Father Joseph DiVivieros, CR speaking about the Creed. All sessions at 7:00 p.m. in McNally Hall.

Stations of the Cross will be publicly prayed each Friday evening at 7:00 p.m. in the Cathedral Basilica and on *Good Friday* at 7:30 p.m.

### Fasting & Works of Charity in Lent

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstaining from meat for all Catholics. Fasting – which means reducing one's food intake during the day i.e. one or two meals instead of three – applies to Catholics, in good health, between the ages of 18 and 59. Abstaining from meat applies to all Catholics 14 and older.

Fasting obtains its full meaning when we deprive ourselves of food in order to be more open to prayer, and to share more in the suffering of those who are hungry. You might consider the money saved on these meals as a Lenten donation to the poor.

Each Lent we might think of "giving something up." The sacrifice of some favorite food or drink in Lent helps us be mindful of those who go without even basic food and drink each day.

In addition to giving up for Lent we might consider *taking on some good practice*. Perhaps this Lent we might focus on being a person of gratitude, or highlighting the goodness of others – rather than pointing out faults.

PARISH FINANCE COUNCIL

The Parish Finance Council met on Saturday, February 8, 2020 to review and approve our 2019 Financial statements which must be submitted to the Diocese. The financial position of the Cathedral Parish remains strong. Our annual Report to the Parish will be available in a couple of weeks. Our 2019 offerings increased by 9.34% over 2018. Expenses also increased due to ongoing of aging infrastructure and sharing in the insurance coverage with the Diocese. Our Parish also had a very good response to the Diocesan campaign One Heart, One Soul. Various projects will begin this summer as a result of the funds raised through the campaign. Thank you to the members of the Parish Finance Council for their helpful advice and guidance in the stewardship of the resources of our Parish. Our Parish Pastoral Council meets in March.

### SAINT THOMAS THE APOSTLE PARISH

Due to the unexpected death of the Pastor of Saint Thomas Parish (Waterdown), Monsignor Sheridan has been named Administrator until a new Pastor is appointed in June.
