WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a Minor Basilica by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's Coat of Arms presents a shield sheltered by the ombrellino, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - every eye shall see him.

THE SEASON OF LENT

The Season of Lent begins with *Ash Wednesday* on February 22. Some ways to observe the Season of Lent as a family and as individuals:

Ash Wednesday, February 22, 2023

Mass with the Imposition of Ashes will be celebrated at **12:00 Noon** and **7:00 p.m.** in the Cathedral Basilica. *Ash Wednesday is a day of fast (Catholics 14 – 59 years of age) and abstinence from meat for all Catholics.*

Stations of the Cross

Traditional Lenten devotion marks the 14 steps (stations) taken by Christ on the road to Calvary. **Fridays** in Lent at **7:00 p.m.**

Daily Mass in Lent

Tuesday through Friday at **12:00 Noon** in the Cathedral Basilica.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Rite of Election welcoming those to be baptized from Parishes across the Diocese on Sunday, February 26 at 1:30 p.m. in the Cathedral Basilica.

McNally Hall Update

The work of restoring the terrazzo floor in McNally Hall is nearing completion. In the coming week painters will freshen the walls with a new coat of paint and we'll re-open on February 28th for the Lenten Day of Prayer for Priests.

PEW RE-FINISHING

Our crew of painters continues to make progress re-finishing the pews in the Cathedral Basilica. They are removing the old speaker system on the pew backs. All in preparation for the "big lift" in the Spring. The pews will be lifted as the carpet is removed and new flooring installed. We hope to have the final schema of the new flooring ready to present to parishioners in the coming weeks.

NEW MASS PARTS

Over the next couple of weeks we'll be learning a new Mass Setting which we'll begin using at Sunday Mass on February 26. The Belmont Mass setting was composed by Christopher Walker. It is a relatively simple chant – hopefully we'll adapt to it fairly easily. Thanks to Rob Corso, our Music Director, and the Parish Cantors for their support of our Assembly's singing. Remember what Saint Augustine said ... when you sing, you pray twice!

NEW ARCHBISHOP

The Holy Father, Pope Francis, has given the Church in Ontario a great gift with the appointment of a new Archbishop of Toronto. He announced on Saturday, February

11th - feast of Our Lady of Lourdes - the appointment of Bishop Francis Leo (Auxiliary Bishop of Montreal) as the new Archbishop in succession to His Eminence, Thomas Cardinal Collins, whose resignation the Holy Father accepted. Archbishop Leo is friend of Bishop Crosby, and of the Diocese of Hamilton. His experience as a Priest, Seminary formator, Lecturer, diplomatic service on behalf of the Holy See, and work with the Canadian conference of Catholic Bishops has prepared him well for the leadership of the Archdiocese of Toronto. In that position he is also the Metropolitan Archbishop of the ecclesiastical Province of Toronto, which includes the Dioceses of Toronto, Hamilton, London, St. Catharine's and the Thunder Bay. We pray for him as he takes on this new ministry in the Church and as he prepares for his installation at Saint Michael's Cathedral Basilica. We look forward to welcoming our new Metropolitan Archbishop to the Diocese of Hamilton in the next few months. An opportunity to thank and honour His Eminence Cardinal Collins will take place at our Mass of Chrism on April 3rd as we acknowledge his 50th anniversary of Ordination as a Priest of Hamilton Diocese.
