The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a Minor Basilica by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's Coat of Arms presents a shield sheltered by the ombrellino, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - every eye shall see him.

COUNTDOWN TO LENT

The Season of Lent begins this week! Ash Wednesday, is February 26. Ashes (from last year's palm branches) will be blessed and imposed during Mass in the Cathedral Basilica at **8:00 a.m.; 12:00 Noon** and **7:00 p.m.** All are welcome. Plan to join us for the *Lenten Retreat* a series of weekly reflections on Tuesdays with guest speakers. Our first session will be on Tuesday, March 3rd with Anne Jamieson and David Dayler speaking about the "Our Father". All sessions at 7:00 p.m. in McNally Hall.

Stations of the Cross will be publicly prayed each Friday evening at 7:00 p.m. in the Cathedral Basilica and on *Good Friday* at 7:30 p.m.

Fasting & Works of Charity in Lent

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstaining from meat for all Catholics. Fasting – which means reducing one's food intake during the day i.e. one or two meals instead of three – applies to Catholics, in good health, between the ages of 18 and 59. Abstaining from meat applies to all Catholics 14 and older.

Fasting obtains its full meaning when we deprive ourselves of food in order to be more open to prayer, and to share more in the suffering of those who are hungry. You might consider the money saved on these meals as a Lenten donation to the poor.

Each Lent we might think of "giving something up." The sacrifice of some favorite food or drink in Lent helps us be mindful of those who go without even basic food and drink each day.

In addition to giving up for Lent we might consider *taking on some good practice*. Perhaps this Lent we might focus on being a person of gratitude, or highlighting the goodness of others – rather than pointing out faults.

RITE OF ELECTION

His Excellency, Bishop Crosby will preside at the celebration of the *Rite of Election* on Sunday, March 1st, 2020 in the Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King. This celebration gathers all those who will be Baptized, Confirmed and initiated to the Lord's Table of the Eucharist at the Easter Vigil. Parishes from Brant, Hamilton and Halton Deaneries – and some other parts of the Diocese – will participate in this celebration. Our two Catechumens – Dean & Leslie will be among those declared to be "Elect" by the Bishop. Please pray for them as the Easter Sacraments draw near.

RITES OF SCRUTINY

After the *Rite of Election* on March 1st, the *Elect* will participate in the *Rites of Scrutiny* on the Third, Fourth and Fifth Sundays of Lent. These ancient rites – together with the proclamation of John's Gospels for those Sundays invite the Elect to a deeper conversion. The Gospels include the *woman at the well, the man born blind,* and *the raising of Lazarus from the dead*. The Scrutinies will be celebrated during the 9 a.m. Mass.
