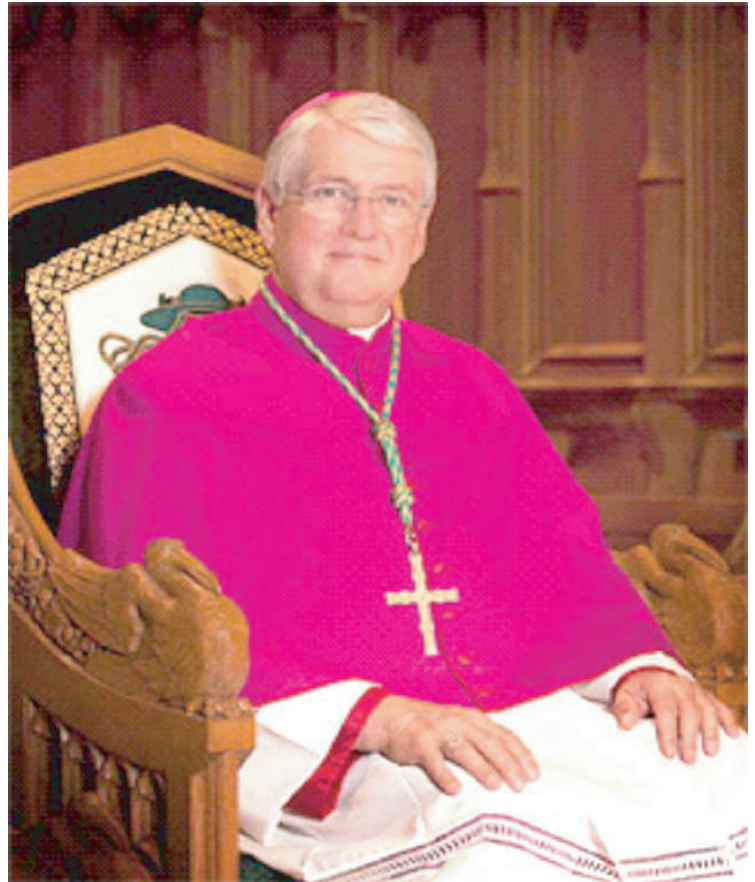

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

The questionnaire seeks information from the faithful on the content of the *Lineamenta*, which is the working document for the upcoming Synod. It can be completed on-line, or printed and faxed or mailed to the Family Ministry Office. **The deadline for submission is Feb. 27, 2015.**

Attend one of two focus group gatherings during which the questionnaire will be discussed and responses collected to include in the final report. **Both gatherings will occur from 7:00 - 9:00 pm** and you are asked to RSVP by phone (905-528-7988 ext. 2249) or e-mail (familyministry@hamiltondiocese.com) if you plan to attend. COUNTDOWN TO LENT!

The Season of Lent begins with **Ash Wednesday** on Wednesday, February 18th. Three Masses with the imposition of Ashes will be celebrated in the Cathedral Basilica at **8:00 a.m.**; **12:00 Noon**; and **7:00 p.m.**

Ash Wednesday is a penitential day of fasting and abstaining from meat. Catholics between the ages of 14 – 59 (who are in good health) are obligated to fast, and all Catholics are invited to abstain from meat on this day. A penitential fast may mean going without some of our favourite foods or desserts for the day. We may consider reducing our intake of food for the day. The idea is to experience physical hunger, so that we might recognize our spiritual hunger for God.

In Canada, Catholics are encouraged to abstain from meat on the Fridays of Lent ... it's a pious practice to do this throughout the year ... if it is not possible, we are invited to do some charitable act instead.

Join us each Friday in Lent for **Stations of the Cross** at 7:00 p.m. and a video presentation by Fr. Robert Barron on *Virtues and Vices* in McNally Hall (Auditorium) at 7:30 p.m. ... begins on February 20th.

We continue to journey with those preparing for Baptism, Confirmation, and first reception of the Eucharist at the Easter Vigil which will be celebrated on Saturday, April 4th.

Make this a holy Lent of fasting, almsgiving and growth in prayer so that we may share more fully in the joy of Easter!

NEWS FROM THE PARISH ADVISORY BOARD
