### WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

There are thirty-four Sundays of Ordinary Time - which is broken up by Lent and Easter. This year we will hear from the Gospel of Mark on most of Ordinary Time is these Sundays. opportunity to reflect on the life and ministry of Jesus from week to week. Sunday is the day of the Lord's Resurrection. From Apostolic times, Christians observe the first day of the week to gather, to hear the Word, to be fed with His very presence in the Eucharist, and to be sent forth as disciples in the world. On the weekdays of Ordinary Time feasts of various Saints and mysteries of faith are celebrated and indicated in the Mass intentions in the bulletin.
