

## WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a Minor Basilica by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's Coat of Arms presents a shield sheltered by the ombrellino, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - every eye shall see him.

### BAPTISM OF THE LORD

Today's Feast of the Baptism of the Lord concludes the Christmas Season. Christ is manifest in his birth, in his epiphany and in his baptism in the River Jordan by John the Baptist. On that great day, as he rose from the waters, all heard the Father's voice ... "this is my Son, the beloved, in whom I am pleased." From this moment his public ministry began which culminated in his passion, death and resurrection. In our baptism we are initiated into this same Paschal Mystery. As we rise from the waters of baptism, we begin a new mission - to be fulfilled during our whole life - as a disciple of the Lord. Strengthened by the Father's love in our hearts, we are sent forth to grow in the image of Jesus Christ. Our baptism transforms our life ... in turn we are called to transform the world in which we live. Baptism calls us to *holiness of life*. It prepares us to be Saints. Let us call upon the grace of our own baptism to strengthen us and to guide us as we seek to follow the Lord in our lives.

### ORDINARY TIME

Today's feast also marks a transition to *Ordinary Time*. The 34 Sundays of this liturgical Season invite us to enter more deeply into the mystery of Jesus life and ministry as we hear from the Gospel of Matthew. The Season of Lent begins on *Ash Wednesday* (February 26), which means there is a break in Ordinary Time until the conclusion of the Easter Season after the Feast of Pentecost.
