WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

Ordinary Time

The liturgical Season of *Ordinary Time* began earlier this week after the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord (Monday). There are Thirty-four weeks in this Season which focus on our life in Christ. This year in Ordinary Time our Gospel passages on Sundays are taken primarily from the Gospel of Mark. We also hear from the Gospel of John on some Sundays in the coming year. This year we will observe 6 weeks of Ordinary Time before **Lent** begins on Ash Wednesday which will celebrate on **Wednesday**, **February 14th**, **2018**. After the Lent/Easter cycle the Season of Ordinary Time will continue with the Seventh Week.

Pope Francis on the Liturgy

At his weekly Wednesday audience our Holy Father has been offering teachings on the celebration of the Liturgy. Below are his recent comments on the Penitential Act at

each Mass.

Dear brothers and sisters: In our catechesis on the Holy Eucharist, today we consider the penitential rite. To prepare ourselves to celebrate worthily the sacred mysteries, we acknowledge, before God and our brothers and sisters, that we have sinned. Significantly, we make this confession as a community, yet in the Confiteor each of us speaks personally: "I confess... that I have sinned." Like the humble publican in Jesus' parable, we strike our breast and recognize that we are unworthy of the gift of God's mercy and forgiveness. We then beg the intercession of Our Lady and all the angels and saints to sustain us on the path of holiness and The priest then pronounces the conversion. absolution - "May almighty God have mercy on us, forgive us our sins, and bring us to everlasting life". Unlike the absolution granted in confession, this does not remit mortal sin, yet it expresses our trust in God's promise of forgiveness and reconciliation. We thus join the great line of biblical figures - like David, the Prodigal Son and Saint Peter - who, conscious of their sin, acknowledged it before God with confidence in the transforming power of his
