WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY

This annual observance is an invitation to all Christians to promote unity through actions and mutual respect. During this week we are called to pray for the unity of the Church ... just as Christ did the night before he died.

SUNDAY OF THE WORD OF GOD

This year's observance of the Sunday of the Word of God is a call to recognize the importance of Scriptures in the Sacred Liturgy. The Second Vatican Council (1962 - 1965) promoted the importance of the Word of God in the Sacred liturgy. The Council called for a more abundant use of Scripture at the Eucharist and in each of the Sacraments. Today, the "Lectionary" (book of readings) contains Scripture passages arranged in a 3-year cycle. Year A focuses on the Gospel of Matthew; Year B on Mark; and Year C on Luke. The Gospel of John is heard during Christmas, Lent and Easter Seasons. The first reading each week is taken from the Old Testament and usually matches in theme with the Gospel. A responsorial psalm - taken from the Book of Psalms - is sung after the reading. A second reading is a passage taken from one of the Letters of Saint Paul in the New Testament, or from one of the other pastoral epistles of The homily, following the Peter or John. Gospel, is an integral part of the Liturgy of the Word. It is offered by an ordained bishop, priest or deacon and is meant to be based on the Scriptures proclaimed at that liturgy. A good homilist weaves the Biblical passages with the experience of life today. For most Catholics we hear the Word of God at Sunday or Daily Mass and in the celebration of the Sacraments. It is also a good habit to use the Sacred Scripture in our daily prayer. Our Sunday bulletin always includes the Scripture passage references for the readings proclaimed at Mass for the week. A good habit would be to use the Sunday Gospel, or other readings, as part of our daily prayer. Studying Scripture helps us grow in our love for God's Word. PAPAL HONOURS

The celebration of Papal Honours originally scheduled for January 3rd, has now been postponed until **Sunday**, **June 27**th, **2021** at **1:30 p.m.** His Holiness, Pope Francis has honoured a number of parishioners from across the Diocese of Hamilton. Our own Barb Dollak – former co-ordinator of the Office of Refugees for the Diocese – has been awarded the *Bene Merenti* medal. Also, Father Martin Vallely – pastor at Holy Rosary Parish, Burlington – has been named a *Chaplain of His Holiness* with the title "Monsignor." These, and the other honours, will be bestowed in June. Congratulations and thank you for your work for the Lord and His Church!

DIOCESAN APPOINTMENTS

His Excellency, Bishop Crosby, has announced that our new Auxiliary Bishop, Bishop-Elect Wayne Lobsinger will be the *Director of Vocations and Priestly Formation* in addition to his other responsibilities. Father Paul Edmondstone is appointed the Pastoral Administrator of Saint Ann Parish, until a new Pastor arrives in June. Our own Monsignor Sheridan will assist Father Edmondstone with the financial administration of the Parish. These appointments took effect on January 6, 2021.
