

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

ORDINARY TIME

We find ourselves as a Christian community in *Ordinary Time* once again. Yet there is nothing *ordinary* here! The Sundays of the year that do not fall into the major liturgical seasons are numbered as Sundays of Ordinary Time. It is a weekly opportunity to listen for the teaching, healing, and saving work of Christ Jesus as it unfolds in the Gospel readings and the Scriptures assigned by the Church for each Sunday. This year we are in "Year A" which means that on the Sundays of Ordinary Time we will hear passages taken from the Gospel of Matthew. Let us open our hearts and minds to hear the Word of the Lord and put it into practice in our lives!

We have a total of eight weeks of Ordinary Time before the beginning of Lent. This holy Season of prayer and penance begins with *Ash Wednesday* on **Wednesday**, **March 5**th. The forty days of Lent prepare us to renew our baptismal commitment in the joy of Easter on Sunday, April 20th.

This year we will offer a study opportunity for parishioners on each Wednesday (daytime) and Fridays (after Stations). Plan to join us for this informative reflection on our call to the *new Evangelization* and what it means in our lives.




