

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

DAY OF PRAYER FOR CONSECRATED LIFE Sunday, February 2 is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord and the annual Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life. The vocation to Consecrated Life

involves those men and women who make lifetime vows of *poverty, chastity, and obedience* in the service of the Church. Most men and women in Consecrated Life express their vocation as part of a religious community. Some live their vocation in the world. Today we pray that all Consecrated men and women may grow in love for their vocation and for the Church they are called to serve. We pray for the many good works that these religious do in varied ways within the Church and for the good of the world. May this day be an opportunity for them to grow in their zeal and "rekindle the fervor which should inspire their offering themselves to the Lord" (Blessed Pope John Paul II, 1997).

To become a "Bishop's Server" a young person will have been a Junior Server for at least one year, will have been Confirmed, and will be attending High School.

INCOME TAX RECEIPTS & PARISH SUPPORT

2013 Income Tax receipts are being mailed in the coming week. These receipts reflect the generosity of many parishioners who have chosen to support the work of the Cathedral Parish with their financial contributions. All donations received in this manner tax deductible.

Many parishioners use Sunday Offering envelopes as their primary way of making donations to the parish.

Some choose to use "pre-authorized" debits. The convenience of this method is that one is not searching for Offering Envelopes, or for change to put in them. By designated an amount to be withdrawn on a monthly basis one pre-determines the tax benefit of the contribution. The advantage for the parish is a steady stream of income each month.

In the near future our financial report for 2013 will be presented to the parish – once it is approved by the Parish Finance Council – it is a story of generosity and good work in maintaining the programs and physical plant of our parish.
