The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a Minor Basilica by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's Coat of Arms presents a shield sheltered by the ombrellino, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - every eye shall see him.

Bible Sunday

In December, Bishop Crosby announced that he has established the *Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time* as **Bible Sunday**. This annual observance is in response to Pope

Francis' expressed desire in the Apostolic Letter *Misericordia et misera* (at the conclusion of the Year of Mercy, 2016) "that God's word be increasingly celebrated, known and disseminated, so that the mystery of love streaming forth from this font of mercy may be ever better understood." You will find a book mark for Bible Sunday attached to today's bulletin. You may wish to use it in your Bible as you follow these suggestions for praying with Sacred Scripture:

Praying with the Bible

Find a comfortable place ...

Choose a passage ... maybe the Gospel assigned for Sunday Mass – the reference is found in the bulletin – or one of the weekday Gospel passages.

Invite the Holy Spirit to open your mind and heart.

Read the passage one time – digest the words, get a sense of the phrases, sit with the Word so that it might seep more deeply into your consciousness.

Read the passage again – how does the word speak to you in this time and place; what emotions are evoked by the passage; how does the Word speak to me of God and how does it impact my life?

Conclude with the *Our Father* and a prayer of thanksgiving to the Holy Spirit.
