#### LITURGICAL CALENDAR

Next Sunday's Feast of the Baptism of the Lord marks the end of the Christmas Season. We transition into Ordinary Time. The thirty four Sundays of Ordinary Time form the better part of the Liturgical Year. This coming year (Year C of the Lectionary) we'll hear from the Gospel of Luke each Sunday. Between now and the beginning of Lent (March 6) we will observe eight Sundays in Ordinary Time. These are weeks that we focus on the preaching, teaching and ministry of Jesus. The liturgical colour of Ordinary Time is green – a reminder of the hope that is ours in Christ Jesus.

#### 2018 INCOME TAX RECEIPTS

In the coming weeks our office will prepare and mail out 2018 Income Tax receipts to those donors who have made "recorded" contributions to the parish through Sunday Offering envelopes, pre-authorized debits, or other donations. The CRA requires that these receipts be sent out

before the end of February. Our Parish Finance Council will meet in mid-February to approve our 2017 Financial Report for submittal to the Diocese and reporting to the Parish.

Boxed sets of Sunday Offering Envelopes have been prepared for pick up between the King Street doors. Please take your boxed set for use in 2019. Please do not begin using the envelopes until January. If you would like to become an envelope user please contact our Parish Office or complete a Registration form found at the entrances of the Church or online. An alternate method of offering your financial sacrifice for the Parish is through *pre-authorized bank debits*. PAD forms are available at the entrances of the Church. Income Tax receipts are offered for all donations to the Parish offered through the envelopes or by PAD donations.

#### WEDDINGS IN 2020

Couples who are planning to marry in 2020 should begin the process by contacting the Parish. We require one full year's notice of marriage. To avoid disappointment it's always best to make arrangements for the Church before committing to a banquet hall for the reception. consult our Parish website Please www.ctkbasilica.ca for further information and an application for marriage. Both parties to marriage must be free of any prior bond of marriage. At least one party (either bride or groom) must be Catholic and resident in the Diocese of Hamilton.
