BIBLE SUNDAY

The Second Annual *Bible Sunday* will be observed in Hamilton Diocese on Sunday, February 3, 2019. The focus of this year's observance is "*Listening to God's Word at Mass*". Two special presentations on the Gospel of Luke will be offered by Fr. Michael Patella, O.S.B. St. Michael Parish, Waterloo (2:00 - 3:30 p.m.) and the **Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King, Hamilton (7:00 - 8:30 p.m.)**. COUNTDOWN TO LENT

The Season of Lent begins with our observance of *Ash Wednesday - March 6, 2019*. This five week period is an opportunity - through the penitential acts of *prayer, fasting, and abstinence from meat*. Through our prayer and devotions, Lent invites us to journey more deeply into the mystery of the Lord's passion and death, so that we can share more fully in the new life he brings in the Resurrection. The forty days of Lent recall the forty year journey of God's people from slavery to freedom and Jesus' own 40 day journey in the desert at the start of his public ministry.

WORLD YOUTH DAY 2019

Catholic youth and young adult pilgrims from around the world are descending upon Panama City, Panama. Held every two to three years, World Youth Day is an international gathering of youth and young adults (15-30 years old) for a celebration of the Catholic faith. Numerous Bishops, priests, consecrated people, and lay faithful also take part in gathering to experience their common faith in Christ. It is estimated that some 500,000 people will participate in this year's event with an emphasis on prayer, spiritual formation, and cultural exchange.

Canada will be represented in Panama by a strong delegation of more than 1,000 pilgrims representing over 20 dioceses, religious institutes, and ecclesial movements from across the country. In addition, nine Bishops from Canada will attend WYD to accompany the pilgrims during the encounter. Several Canadian Bishops will attend WYD. The Bishops in attendance will be joined by 18 priests, 30 volunteers and 11 representatives from the media. A number of Bishops from Canada will likewise be giving catechesis during the days in Panama City.
