

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him.*

The bride and groom themselves arrange an appointment to meet the Rector and arrange a date for marriage. Available dates are not discussed by telephone or email. RESTORATION UPDATE

Work continues on the Cathedral. Soon scaffolding will be removed on the West side to reveal the work that has been completed. Most of the scaffold around the Bishop's house will also be removed. The cleaned stone gives us a clear sense of what the Cathedral looked like in 1933. We are making great progess on the stone restoration and roof replacement.
