WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a Minor Basilica by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's Coat of Arms presents a shield sheltered by the ombrellino, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

CATHEDRAL OPEN FOR VISITS

PAPAL VISIT TO FIRST NATIONS

The Holy See recently confirmed the Holy Father's itinerary for his upcoming visit to Canada to meet with indigenous peoples. He committed to the visit early in the Spring. He will land in Edmonton and stay for a couple of days of encounters and liturgies with first nations. His next stop will be Quebec City for Mass at Sainte Anne de Beaupre, prayer and meeting with the Bishops of Canada, meetings with officials, and then on to a stop in Iqaluit and then home to Rome.
