The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

Construction Update

Gold-coloured cladding was recently installed on the Cross atop the Cathedral Basilica bell tower. This new cladding replaces the original copper cladding which had been painted gold at some point in our history. The new cladding is a combination of metals similar to the composition of the Canadian \$1 coin. Like a "loonie" it may dull over time, but will retain a golden colour. The contractor is in the process of removing the top four levels of scaffolding from the bell tower. Work continues on the lower sections of the tower and the South facade of the We are still on track for Cathedral Basilica. completion by this Fall! We anticipate beginning work on the front doors of the Cathedral Basilica sometime in the coming weeks. This work will involve the closure of each set of doors during the process - we'll advise of any changes in door openings as the work proceeds. Decorative pinnacles - replacements for the originals - have been completed by the stonemasons and are being installed on the South façade. Similar work is already completed on the bell tower.

CCCB Statement on Bill C-16

As President of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops, Bishop Crosby issued the following letter on Bill C-16:

Bill C-16, An Act to amend the Canadian Human Rights Act and the Criminal Code, was recently passed by the Parliament of Canada and received royal assent on 19 June 2017. This Act adds gender identity and gender expression to the list of prohibited grounds of discrimination under the Canadian Human Rights Act, and also modifies the Criminal Code to extend the protection against hate crimes to members of groups distinguished by gender identity or expression.

The Catholic Church sees all people, regardless of how they identify themselves or the manner in which they choose to live their lives, as possessing equally an inherent dignity bestowed on them by God our Creator. For this reason, unjust discrimination or violence against a person or community or class of persons is always morally wrong. From the moment of conception onward, every human being has the innate dignity of bearing the image of God. All persons, including those who identify as "transgender," must always be treated with compassion, respect, and love.

While the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops supports Bill C-16's intention to protect Canadians from harm, some of the principles behind the legislation – even if widely accepted in our society – cannot be endorsed by Catholics. The most serious of these is the claim that gender is separable from biological sexuality and is to be determined by the individual. This central tenet of contemporary gender theory is not in accord with natural law or Christian revelation and has therefore been explicitly rejected by Pope Francis and by Pope Benedict XVI.

According to Genesis, we are created male and female, in the image of God (Genesis 1:26, 27). Each of us – man or woman – is challenged to fulfill our human vocation in a way that is individually unique yet true to what we have been created to be. In the words of the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 2332 and 2333, each man and woman "should acknowledge and accept" his or her biological sexual identity, including "physical, moral, and spiritual *difference and complementarity*," which "affects all aspects of the human person in the unity of his body and soul." This identity "especially concerns affectivity, the capacity to love and to procreate, and in a more general way the aptitude for forming bonds of communion with others."

Having in view the well-being, not only of Catholics but of all Canadians, we wish to express again our serious concerns with Bill C-16. Questions about freedom of speech, freedom of association, and freedom of religion are also likely to arise in connection with this legislation. We urge those of Catholic faith, and all people of good will, to be diligent in defending these freedoms and the vision of human dignity on which they are based.*
