

The Most Reverend D. DOUGLAS CROSBY, OMI, DD *Bishop of Hamilton*

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

PARISH BUILDING AND MAINTENANCE

Father Wynen is pleased to announce the formation of the *Parish Building and Maintenance Committee* recently approved by the Parish Finance Council. This Committee will be responsible for advising the Rector in these important matters and co-ordinating with Diocesan officials for the upkeep of the Cathedral Basilica. Members include — Rob McGowan, Dino LeDonne, Tony Cordiero, Sandor Kollarich and Father Wynen. The restoration of the stained glass windows is the first major project that the committee will consider.

CONFIRMATION AT THE CATHEDRAL

Young people from our Parish will celebrate the *Sacrament of Confirmation* on **Saturday, December 6th, 2014** at 5:00 p.m. Mass. Grade 7 students from Canadian Martyrs School ... as well as any Grade 7 student whose family attends our Parish can celebrate the Sacrament with us this year. Registration packages will be available through the School and at the Parish in September. A Parent Meeting will take place in October. Catechetical sessions for the candidates, as well as a Retreat day, will be held at the Cathedral in November to help these young people prepare well for the celebration of Confirmation.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITATION OF ADULTS

Any unbaptized adults who wish to become members of the Catholic Church are invited to speak with Father Wynen by contacting the Parish Office. Adults baptized in other Christian churches or baptized Catholics who have not been Confirmed may also wish to speak with Father about completing their Initiation into the Catholic Church. Our process begins in September.

The Sacrament of Confirmation

The Sacrament of Confirmation follows Baptism as the next Sacrament of Initiation. It is the anointing reserved to the Bishop (or in some cases his delegate) which strengthens and deepens the Gifts of the Holy Spirit already received in Baptism. Our Confirmation marks us as a disciple of the Lord called to be active in the world. The anointing of Confirmation, and the presence of the Holy Spirit, can help us discern God's call in our life. In the Diocese of Hamilton the Sacrament of Confirmation is most often celebrated with young people in <u>Grade 7</u> – some time after the reception of the Eucharist for the first time. This is done for practical and catechetical reasons and also allows the Bishop to confer this Sacrament to as many of the young people as possible. When adults (or children who have reached catechetical age) are baptized, the Sacrament of Confirmation is conferred and the Eucharist is received for the first time in one celebration.

Scriptural Foundation for Confirmation

The Acts of the Apostles speaks of the first Pentecost after the Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ. The disciples were gathered in the Upper Room once again with the doors locked and windows shuttered. Suddenly, a mighty wind blew through the room and tongues of flame settled upon them. A new spirit of boldness rested upon them and they preached the Good News with conviction so that people of various languages could understand them.

In the Gospel, Jesus promises the gift of the Holy Spirit as an Advocate. He tells the Apostles that the Holy Spirit will descend upon them and that they should proclaim the Good News to the ends of the earth and baptize all nations.

The Old Testament also speaks of the Holy Spirit in the very first moments of creation. God breathed life into all that he had created. The Holy Spirit is this breath of life ... the creative energy of the Father and the Son which breaks into the world.

Effects of Confirmation

The Catechism of the Catholic Church, #1294 reminds us that, "... By Confirmation Christians, that is, those who are anointed, share more completely in the mission of Jesus Christ and the fullness of the Holy Spirit with which he is filled so that their lives may give off the *aroma of Christ.*" Those anointed in Confirmation receive the outpouring of the Holy Spirit as the Apostles did on the first Pentecost. We are united to Christ, given the Gifts of the Holy Spirit, and special strength to witness to the Lord in our daily lives.

Confirmation, like Baptism, is conferred only once. It gives a "character" which signifies that Jesus Christ has marked this individual with the seal of the Spirit.

The Rite of Confirmation

The Bishop is the "ordinary" minister of Confirmation, however, there are occasions when a Priest may be delegated to Confirm in place of the Bishop; or he may confer the Sacrament in certain situations. The Rite of Confirmation usually takes place during the celebration of the Eucharist. After hearing God's Word proclaimed, the Bishop preaches a homily. The candidates for Confirmation are invited to renew their baptismal promises and profess the Catholic faith. The Bishop then extends his hands over those to be confirmed and prays for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon them. Each person to be confirmed then approaches the Bishop and is anointed with Sacred Chrism. The Bishop and the newly confirmed conclude with an exchange a sign of peace. The celebration of Mass continues with the Universal Prayer.

Please pray for our young people who will prepare to celebrate this Sacrament in December.
