WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

MASS INTENTIONS

The Saturday 5:00 p.m. Mass is a *multi-intentional Mass*. Often there are several intentions remembered at this celebration. The intention of the Sunday Masses is always for the people of the Parish.

MAKING THE RETURN ...

It is good to celebrate the liturgy with the holy assembly gathered in prayer. Not all of our Parishioners are fully comfortable making a return to Sunday Mass. Bishop Crosby has extended the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass for the foreseeable future. Making the return to Sunday Mass should be determined by the comfort level and health of each person. All who attend Mass are encouraged to wear a mask and to respect physical distance in seating. If you feel uncomfortable returning to Mass at this time, know that your Parish family is praying with you and for you. Note that televised Mass is available on Salt+Light (television or online). You may wish to note the Scripture readings listed each week in our bulletin to help you pray with the readings at home.

Fr. Don Sanvido conducted a survey to gauge how his community was doing during the crisis. A couple of the responses from his parishioners:

"I had a long talk with my family. We had not attended Mass regularly prior to COVID, but we are now praying the rosary as a family and vow to never miss Mass again for any selfish reason."

"The pandemic has taught us how to be a family again. We are praying together, eating meals together and playing together as a family. I pray the lessons we have learned during this crisis are not forgotten. My family has become stronger because of this."

AT ST. MARY IMMACULATE IN ELORA, CROSS 'DREW US TOGETHER'

A life-size cross touched the hearts of parishioners during the Lenten and Easter seasons at St. Mary Immaculate in Elora. Michael Madden, a St. Mary parishioner, built the cross, which was featured in the Catholic Register, the newspaper of the Archdiocese of Toronto. The cross originally was painted purple and displayed on the front steps of the church for the fifth Sunday of Lent. It was painted red for Palm Sunday, a crown of thorns was added on Good Friday, and it was adorned with flowers for Easter Sunday and again for Pentecost.

"We as a community have picked up our crosses and are carrying it as a sign that Christ is present in the midst of this and not just behind closed doors," Madden said in the Register article.

Parishioner Lynn Kraemer told the Register that many parishioners said it helped them in their Lenten journey, others have left notes at the foot of the cross and one woman wept when the crown of thorns was added. "It drew us together at the heart of who we strive to be — our faith, our religion, the reason we come together in non-COVID times," Kraemer said. "There were no words needed, no grand homilies or proclamations. The cross spoke to each of us, on our own personal journeys, to our individual hearts."
